PIT STOP's Efforts to Help the Environment

There is a lot of talk about "Going Green". You see it everywhere...on your water bottles, post-it notes, copy paper, coffee filters, etc. We can make choices everyday to help the environment. **PIT STOP** is one of those choices.

PIT STOP has consistently found ways to help the environment. In addition to efficient routing, last year we recycled 1 ton of cardboard, 2,500 aluminum cans, dozens of toner cartridges, and our office staff does not throw a way a piece of paper until it has been printed on both sides. Another product we recycle are the units themselves. When construction units are not up to **PIT STOP's**

standards, we sell as hunting units rather than taking them to the dump to end up in a landfill.

PIT STOP uses non-formaldehyde deodorant in our units. Which is safe for the environment. In addition, we have switched to non-aerosol cleaning products.

Our industry by its nature is a recycling trade. We remove the waste from the units, and truck it to the county waste water treatment recycling facility. The county then processes the waste water and returns it to rivers and streams. By doing so, this protects the wildlife, public health and our water sources from contamination.
